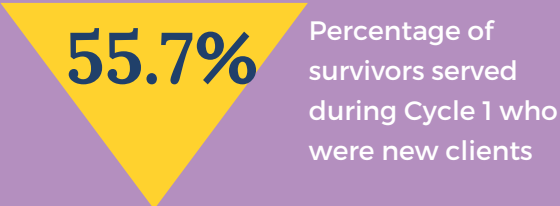
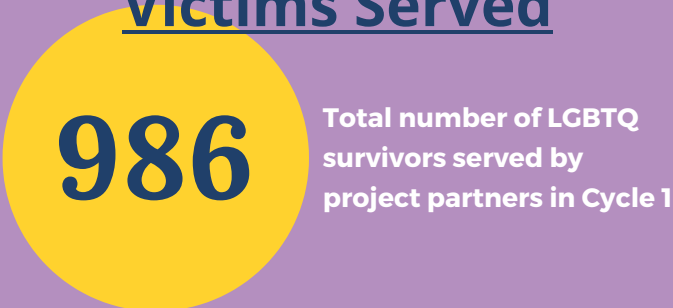
PMT Cycle 1 Data Report

All projects funded by the NC Governor's Crime Commission (GCC) through funds from the Office of Victims of Crime (OVC) are required to submit data quarterly through OVC's Performance Measurement Tool (PMT). Every quarter the UNCG Research & Evaluation Team collects the data required for the PMT from each of the five partner agencies in the NC LGBTQ Domestic Violence Response Initiative. The data are then aggregated across the five agencies and submitted in total for the entire project to OVC. The data in this report reflect information about victims served and service types provided for the first cycle of the grant (Oct 2017-Sep 2020). *Please note that project partners began providing victim services in Jul 2018; therefore, data in this report reflect 9 total quarters of data across the five partner agencies for the entire first cycle of grant funding.*

We feel it is important to report back out to our project partners the results of all of your hard work, so that is the purpose of this brief report. We hope that you can use this information to highlight your agency's efforts as part of a statewide initiative that has provided invaluable assistance to LGBTQ-identified survivors of domestic violence. We will continue to update this report each quarter using all partner agencies' PMT data over the course of the project.
